



## **AUDITION FAQs**

- School Tours are conducted at the start of every school year. You can book through Trybooking to secure a visit. Guided tours of the school are a great way to familiarise yourself with the school's facilities, environment and culture. Tours are also an opportunity for parents and students to ask questions.
- VCASS Open Day is always scheduled in May (see our website or socials for updates).
- VCASS is unzoned, so applicants can apply regardless of where they live.
- As a proud government school, we have a unique approach and a shared purpose in nurturing excellence in students from Years 7-12.
- Please all the required documents on the Auditions and Enrolments page. We recommend you read these documents thoroughly before submitting your application online as it will enhance your knowledge of the audition processes and you will feel more prepared. Please be aware of any fees associated with enrolment that are outlined in these documents.
- You will be notified about your application submission upon completion. There is a nonrefundable Processing Fee of \$100.00 which applies for all applications. This must be paid to process your application.
- VCASS is entry via audition process only. There is no waiting list. This will only occur after applicants have attended an audition and a vacancy may arise in your chosen specialism. • Applicants are advised not to provide a Hotmail email address as they are problematic with information going into your spam.
- Please use an email in the application that you check regularly, so you do not miss out on correspondence from us.
- There is no need to upload personal recommendations in your application, but you may bring a copy to your audition on the day if you feel inclined.
- The outcome of the audition is final and we do not offer feedback to applicants regarding their audition or interviews.
- Should the applicant happen to undergo a family crisis, illness or injury which would prevent them from undertaking the audition, VCASS must be contacted before the commencement of the audition. There may be a later round audition in your chosen program that you can attend.
- VCASS cannot take mid-year entries into the school and we do not accept deferment of a place offered. The applicant would have to re-audition the following year.
- All applicants must attach a student statement (approx 200-300 words) in the application. This is generally one page written by the prospective student on why they would like to attend VCASS. You can also include your personal achievements, hobbies and passions in this statement to help us get a better understanding of who you are and what inspires you.
